Effective upon receipt of this Notice, Item F of Section I, Bulletin No. 1 California Zephyr is amended as follows:

F. Meal Calls - Buffet Service

(A) Buffet and Refreshment Service:

Buffet and refreshment service is to be available to all train patrons on departure of Train 17 from Chicago; and after Breakfast Call on Train 18 from Oakland; and between meals enroute both east and west-bound.

The Dining Car is to be held open for buffet and refreshment service between meals. The Steward will assign a sufficient number of individual crew members to protect the service required during mid-morning and mid-afternoon hours.

The assignment of individual crew members to protect the mid-morning and mid-afternoon service (including necessary side work) is to be alternated, thus permitting the maximum number of crew members a relief period for rest in the Dormitory Car.

Buffet and refreshment service calls will not be made over the public address system.

(B) Changes in Meal Calls:

Train 17:-

2nd Day Dinner--First call at 5 P.M. (M.T.); second call at 6 P.M. (M.T.).

3rd Day Breakfast--First call at 6 A.M. (P.T.).

Train 18:-

1st Day Dinner--First call at 5 P.M. (P.T.); Second call at 6 P.M. (P.T.).

2nd Day Dinner--First call at 5 P.M. (M.T.).
